[REDACTED] was interviewed under oath regarding [REDACTED] knowledge of the Good O' Boy Roundup (GOBR). [REDACTED] provided the following information:

[REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] has been employed with the FLPD for the [REDACTED] [REDACTED] attended the GOBR in 1991, 1992, 1994 and 1995. [REDACTED] has not been interviewed about the GOBR. [REDACTED] learned about the GOBR in 1991. [REDACTED] said [REDACTED] does not remember how [REDACTED] heard about the GOBR. [REDACTED] did not receive an invitation to the 1991 GOBR. [REDACTED] said [REDACTED] received GOBR invitations for the succeeding years. [REDACTED] said the first year [REDACTED] went to the GOBR [REDACTED] made a copy from another invitation.

[REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] FLPD [REDACTED], attended the GOBR in 1991, 1992 and 1995; [REDACTED] FLPD [REDACTED] FLPD [REDACTED] FLPD [REDACTED] attended the GOBR in 1991; [REDACTED] FLPD [REDACTED] FLPD [REDACTED] and [REDACTED], [REDACTED] attended the GOBR in 1995.

[REDACTED] said [REDACTED] thought an Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms agent named Gene Rightmyer organized the GOBR. [REDACTED] mailed [REDACTED] check to attend the GOBR to Rightmyer. [REDACTED] mailed the check to a New Jersey address. [REDACTED] did not remember the address. [REDACTED] met Rightmyer at the 1991 GOBR.

██████████ stated ██████████ did not participate in organizing the events at any of the GOBRs. ██████████ said that ██████████ and ██████████ were members of the board (MOB). ██████████ thought the MOB helped organize events at the GOBR. *TC*

██████████ said ██████████ saw someone wearing a cap with a FBI emblem on it. ██████████ did not know if the person wearing the cap was an FBI agent. ██████████ did not see any federal agents at the GOBR. ██████████ did not see any judges at the GOBR. ██████████ saw many Canadians at the GOBR. ██████████ saw a few American Indians and Hispanic police officers at the GOBR. ██████████ could not recall any names. *TC*

██████████ said ██████████ received a cap, t-shirt, cup and wrist band when ██████████ checked in at the GOBRs. ██████████ thinks the 1991 t-shirt was green with a picture of a man in a canoe holding an M-16 or AR-15. ██████████ said the 1995 t-shirt was white with the words "Bill and Bob's Roadkill Cafe" printed on it. ██████████ did not remember the colors of the 1992 through 1994 t-shirts. *TC*

██████████ stated ██████████ and ██████████ ██████████ FLPD, sold "O.J." t-shirts from the back of ██████████ truck. The "O.J." t-shirt was a hanging faceless stick figure. ██████████ said the stick figure represented "O.J.'s" guilt. ██████████ never saw a picture of "O.J.'s" head in a noose. ██████████ sold about 150 "O.J." t-shirts at the 1995 GOBR. ██████████ said the t-shirt was designed and printed by Primal Screen, located on Griffin Road, one mile east of South Federal Highway, Fort Lauderdale, FL, phone number (305) 587-6350. ██████████ said ██████████ did not see any Martin Luther King or "Boys on the Hood" t-shirts. *TC*

██████████ stated that the GOBR was not a white supremacist or Ku Klux Klan meeting. ██████████ perceived the GOBR as a gathering of cops from all around the country that attended the event to sit around and tell war stories, drink beer, eat and play games. *TC*

██████████ advised that the "Redneck of the Year" contest was held on Saturday after dinner. At the 1991, "Redneck of the Year" contest, ██████████ said ██████████ observed a man named ██████████ run up on stage in ██████████ underwear and urinate over his shoulder. According to ██████████, Bob "swirled the piss over his head like a lariat." ██████████ said ██████████ did not see any racist skits at the roundups. *TC*

██████████ said ██████████ was the watermelon man at the 1992 "Redneck of the Year" contest. ██████████ advised ██████████ dressed as a farmer and carried a watermelon on stage. ██████████ stated that while ██████████ was doing ██████████ redneck skit, ██████████ started moving the watermelon. ██████████ then grabbed a small baseball bat and started hitting the watermelon until it broke. After the watermelon broke, ██████████ said ██████████ reached inside the watermelon and pulled out a black baby doll. ██████████ held the black baby doll in the air and said, "I'm not guilty - I'm not guilty." ██████████ said ██████████ did not consider this skit racist, however, ██████████ admits that someone could interpret the skit racist. ██████████ said ██████████ purchased the baby doll at a store and painted it black. ██████████ said ██████████ did the skit to show solidarity for law *TC*

enforcement due to the criticism law enforcement receives on incidents such as the Rodney King arrest.

██████████ said that in 1991, ██████████ entered and won the ugliest "Good O' Boy" contest. ██████████ won the contest by wearing a pair of underwear on stage and chewing tobacco. ██████████ said ██████████ allowed the chewing tobacco to drool down the side of ██████████ mouth while ██████████ was performing ██████████ skit. According to ██████████, at one point during the skit, ██████████ gave the appearance of taking a "crap." ██████████ said then ██████████ reached into the seat of ██████████ underwear, where ██████████ had previously placed a small wad of chewing tobacco in a zip loc bag. ██████████ grabbed the wad of chewing tobacco and placed it in ██████████ mouth, giving the impression that ██████████ was eating "crap." 7C

██████████ said ██████████ went to Grumpy's each time ██████████ attended the GOBR. ██████████ has met many people at Grumpy's. ██████████ never saw anything happen at Grumpy's other than people talking, dancing and having fun. 7C

██████████ advised ██████████ saw several strippers at the 1995 GOBR. ██████████ said Rightmyer asked the strippers to leave. ██████████ saw one female dancing on top of a car. ██████████ said ██████████ did not see any money given to her. ██████████ did not know the stripper's names. ██████████ did not know anything about prostitution at the GOBRs. 7C

██████████ stated ██████████ did not see any illegal drugs at the GOBRs. ██████████ said ██████████ heard that at the 1991 GOBR, an ATF agent brought some moonshine. ██████████ did not see any moonshine at the 1995 GOBR. 7C

██████████ advised ██████████ watched people play "Chicken Shit Bingo." ██████████ said ██████████ never played "Chicken Shit Bingo." ██████████ stated that "Chicken Shit Bingo" was played on Saturdays at the GOBR. ██████████ said ██████████ had no knowledge of bestiality, goats or sheep at any of the GOBRs. ██████████ had no knowledge of any militia activity at the GOBRs. 7C

██████████ said ██████████ saw Richard Hayward at the 1991 GOBR. According to ██████████, Hayward was wearing a David Duke t-shirt. ██████████ did not see Hayward handing out Duke literature, taking pictures/videos or selling t-shirts. ██████████ stated ██████████ saw David Duke for president signs. ██████████ did not see anyone taking pictures/videos at the roundups. 7C

According to ██████████, ██████████ did not see the confrontation between the ATF officer and the Fort Lauderdale police officer. ██████████ heard that someone was wondering who the black guy was. ██████████ did not know the names of the ATF agents. ██████████ said ██████████ did not see "Nigger Hunting Licenses" or signs at the GOBRs. 7C
