Dear Mr. Conroy:

This is in response to your letter dated February 17, 2008, appealing the withholding of records produced in a search conducted pursuant to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request. Your initial request asked for all information about yourself, as well as records in relation to ICE Office of Professional Responsibility agent Carlos Salazar, his visit to your home on May 23, 2005, and his visit to your work office.

U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) FOIA denied your request on February 27, 2007 finding that the subject matter of the request was part of an ongoing investigation and was exempt under (b)(7)(A). In response to your first appeal of that FOIA response, you were informed that although the underlying investigation that had given rise to the (b)(7)(A) exemption asserted in the initial determination was closed, the entire twenty (20) pages were exempt under (b)(6) and (b)(7)(C). You sent a letter dated February 17, 2008, appealing the administrative appellate decision of February 11, 2008. Upon review of the basis for your appeal, we have determined as follows:

The records which were withheld in full under (b)(6) and (b)(7)(C) may have been withheld erroneously. There appear to be portions of the twenty (20) pages which although reasonably segregable were nonetheless withheld in full. As such, we are remanding this case to ICE FOIA to be re-processed.
