

From Affidavit of Thomas W. Green, Sr.

On April 12, 2001, it came to my attention, through conversation with [redacted] Inspector [redacted] that Senior Customs Inspectors (SCT) [redacted] and [redacted] entered the secured Customs facility (Ward B) with the intention of locating covert video and audio surveillance devices. [redacted] Inspector [redacted] ascertained this information through direct conversation with SCT [redacted] on April 10, 2001, and subsequently made me aware of the incident.

[redacted] Inspector [redacted] did prepare a memorandum on April 12, 2001, which I received documenting his conversation with SCT [redacted]. (I reviewed this memorandum at the Office of Internal Affairs prior to preparing this affidavit).

I was contacted by [redacted] Inspector [redacted], who is currently the [redacted] and assigned to this position full time. I believe he telephoned me on April 9th. As I recall, [redacted] asked me about the cameras. As I further recall, I told him that I was aware of the discovery of the cameras and that I had taken the appropriate action. I did not tell SCT [redacted] that the cameras did not belong in Customs or Internal Affairs as I was directed previously by David Marwell. I do not recall telling [redacted] that I would call him back after I spoke to Internal Affairs.

However, since I already received instructions from the Office of Internal Affairs, David Marwell, there would of been no need to call [redacted] back to further address the issue. I never told [redacted] or anyone else that they were authorized to go to Jackson Memorial Hospital to look for more cameras.

Again, I had no knowledge of SCT's [redacted] and [redacted] entering the Ward B area, with the intention of locating/verifying covert video and or audio devices until advised on April 12, 2001. I immediately instructed [redacted] Inspector [redacted] to gather written statements from both SCT's [redacted] and [redacted] regarding their actions on April 9, 2001, regarding their actions. I did also review their written memos at the Office of Internal Affairs in order to recollect the facts and circumstances as I have outlined above.

The contents of this statement are true and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief.
