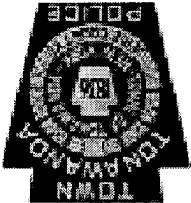

On 11/28/2013, I responded to 2250 Niagara Falls Blvd. (Shannon Pub) to speak with [redacted] at approximately 1355 hrs. [redacted] believed he may have been drugged at 2316 Niagara Falls Blvd. (Slick Willie's) at approximately 0010 hrs.

[redacted] went out for a night of fun with his roommate, [redacted]. The two arrived at Slick Willie's at approximately midnight on 11/28/2013. [redacted] recalled having three or four beers since arriving at the bar. The last thing [redacted] remembered was playing a game of pool.

[redacted] woke up in his apartment at approximately 1130 hrs. on 11/28/2013. At this time, [redacted] noticed brush burns on the left side of his face and had no idea how they were sustained. [redacted] also noticed two of the four rings he was wearing were missing from his fingers. [redacted] found his wallet in his pocket, where he usually keeps it. When he opened the wallet, he noticed approximately \$90.00 was missing.

[redacted] spoke with [redacted] about what happened between the game of pool and the time he woke up. [redacted] stated he was talking to an unknown female at Slick Willie's when he heard "by word of mouth" that [redacted] had been escorted out of the bar by the establishment's bouncers. [redacted] exited the bar at approximately 0130 hrs. to find [redacted] outside on the ground. [redacted] was alone and had brush burns on his face, but no one on scene knew why. [redacted] transported [redacted] to their residence to allow him to sleep.

[redacted] believes he may have been beaten up at Slick Willie's. He also believes his money and rings were stolen. He did not recall having any confrontations during his time at the bar. He is unsure why he was escorted out of the establishment in the first place and does not recall being asked to leave. He believes he was drugged because he consumes alcohol often and three or four beers do not usually effect him the way they did on this occasion. [redacted] did not recall letting any of the three or four beers out of his sight while at Slick Willie's.

[redacted] stated he could not remember exactly what his rings looked like, only that they were both sterling silver. He stated he always wears four and woke up wearing only two. One of the missing two had a "Fleur De Lis" design. [redacted] did not think it strange for someone to remove his wallet from his pocket, take \$90.00, and make the effort to fold the wallet and place it back inside his pocket.

[redacted] was treated by Town of Tonawanda Paramedic Bongiovanni. [redacted] reported no additional injuries and declined hospital transport. I issued [redacted] Complaint #13-351091.

[redacted] spoke with [redacted]. His story was consistent with what [redacted] had told me. [redacted] stated he did not see [redacted] involved in any altercation inside of Slick Willie's. [redacted] stated he was away from [redacted] speaking with an unknown female, and did not see [redacted] escorted out of the bar. [redacted] was not sure who told him [redacted] was outside of the bar.

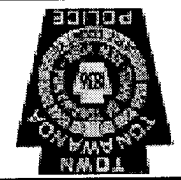
Myself and Detective Moore responded to Slick Willie's, however, the business was closed. I did observe a

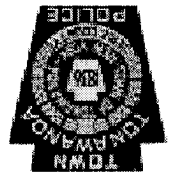

security camera outside of the establishment. We canvassed the area outside of the bar, but were unable to find anything that may have been considered evidence of a crime. The brush burns on [redacted] face appeared to be the result of contact with a textured surface. The injuries were not consistent with some sort of blunt force trauma. It appeared as though the brush burns could have been caused from [redacted] face coming in contact with the pavement outside of Slick Willie's. It is unknown if [redacted] took some sort of fall while he was on location. [redacted] was unable to determine whether his rings and money were lost or stolen. At this time, it is unknown if any crime actually took place. See Detective Moore's supplement.

was still on scene and was subsequently arrested for a criminal contempt charge for violating an stay away order of protection with the petitioner being . Refer to domestic report #13-352029.

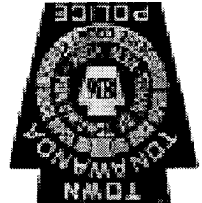

came to the front desk to report that his sister, [redacted], is in the company of her boyfriend, [redacted], and that [redacted] believes that [redacted] is being held against her will. [redacted] told me that he believes that [redacted] and [redacted] flew to Las Vegas sometime after Tuesday this week and then went to Los Angeles where [redacted] purchased a red Ferrari before driving to Texas. [redacted] further went on to tell me that he has received phone calls and text messages from his sister, but that the phone calls are very short and he believes that [redacted] is telling his sister what to say. Further, [redacted] explained that he believes that the text messages he has received from [redacted] are actually being written by [redacted] because of the way they are constructed. According to [redacted], the texts appear to be written from someone who speaks little English. Due to [redacted] past history of involvement in the Mexican drug trade, [redacted] is very concerned about his sister's welfare.

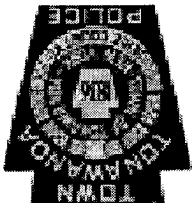
I called Immigration and Customs' Enforcement and spoke with Agent [redacted] ( [redacted] ) and also with Supervising Agent [redacted]. Both ICE agents told me that there are no restraints on [redacted] ability to travel within the United States and that by him leaving NYS, he has not committed any crime. Agent [redacted] did, however, say that he is interested in following up with [redacted] concerning any charges against him and requested that we keep him apprised of any dealings with [redacted]. According to [redacted] he believes that [redacted] and his sister may be on their way back to Buffalo with the red Ferrari. [redacted] believes the above to be true based on the limited texts and conversations he has had with his sister. I advised [redacted] that I will follow up with this information by checking [redacted] apartment tomorrow night during my shift to see if he has returned home.
